

# Delta's Green Efforts

- Guest rooms have Energy Efficient Compact Fluorescent bulbs.
- Switched ballasts from T12's to T8's; more energy efficient.
- Water diverters in guestroom toilets; saves 1 liter of water each time a toilet is flushed.
- Use refillable ink cartridges; and emails are not printed.
- Light switches are placed on auto, and heat set at a range of 18°-22°.
- Computers are switched off overnight.
- Meeting pads and pens are offered upon request.
- Recycle bins are placed in every meeting room, office, work area and guestroom.
- No disposable containers are used (other than sugar packets due to health regulations); cream, water and milk are all placed in jugs.
- Disable one automatic door during the winter to prevent hot air from escaping.
- Permanently dim all lights in the lobby and public areas to conserve energy.
- Green Orientation: provide handbooks on discs, as well as use recycled paper, recyclable pens, folders and Delta bags.
- Delta policies are presented on power point presentations for review, and then one page is printed off for sign off.
- Meeting packages, proposals and menus are sent to clients via email or fax; reduces paper consumption.
- The Hotel has an active Environmental and Energy Green Committee.
- Started a herb garden in order to produce our own, instead of having it shipped in.
- Best practice of turning off the gas in the kitchen and laundry room when not in use.
- More accuracy when placing orders to prevent secondary deliveries and/or using our personal vehicles to purchase products.
- The Executive Chef purchases the hotel's produce locally at the Fredericton Market.
- Partially used soaps and shampoos are given to companies or organizations that request those products.
- Towel change program; where towels are only changed upon guest requests.
- All cleaning chemicals are environmentally friendly products.
- Sheets, blankets and other products are donated to local community groups.
- Active Participant in Earth Hour.
